Judging for regional awards took place at the Association's national headquarters in Des Plaines, Illinois, in mid-January. An impartial panel of judges who are experts within the industry and associated fields selected winners based on each entrant's "before and after" photography and project description. Judging was based on problem solving, functionality, aesthetics, craftsmanship, innovation, degree of difficulty, and entry presentation.

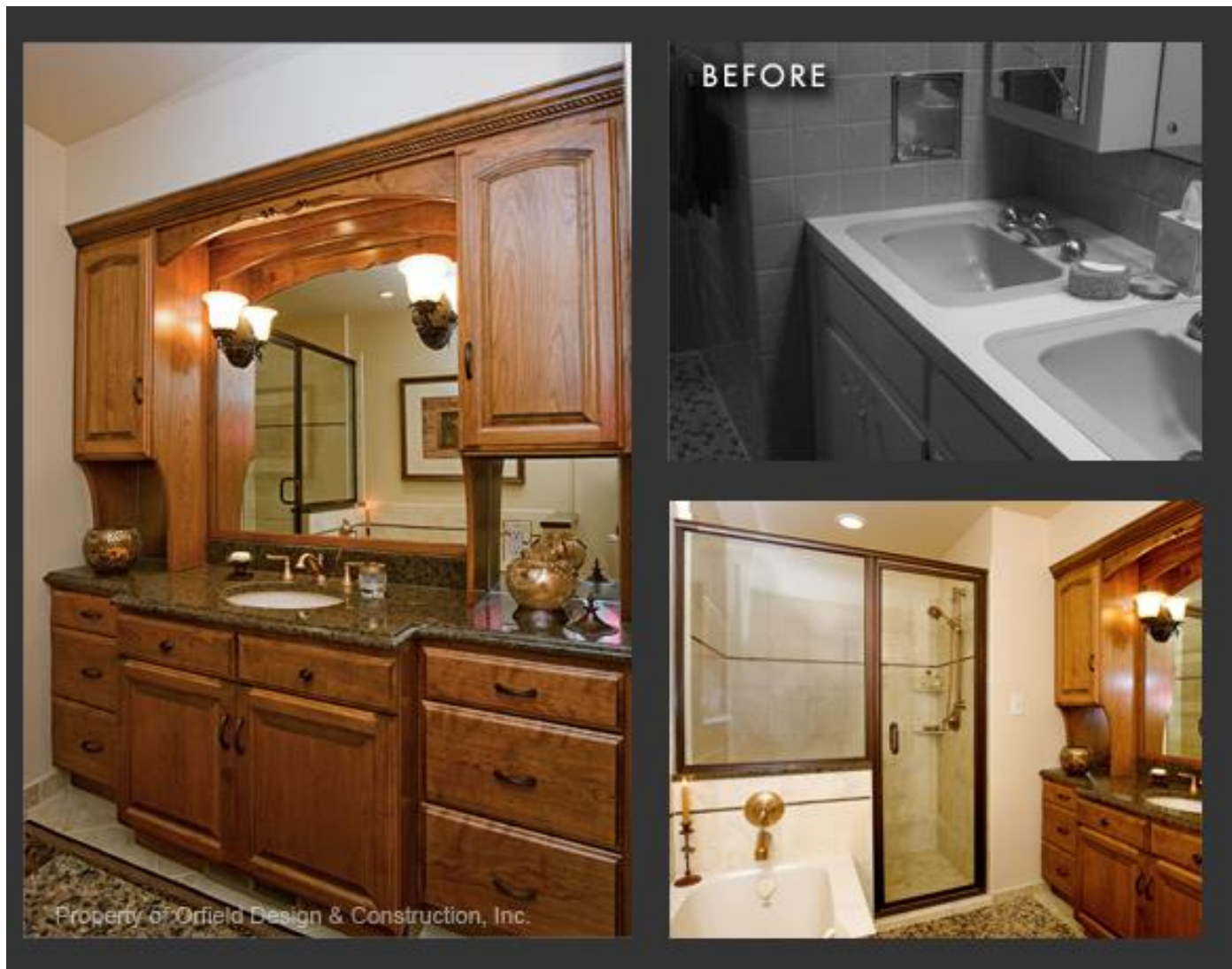

The original 1950's bathroom on the interior of this Saint Paul home had poor lighting, a cramped shower and outdated finishes. The remodeled bathroom features a large shower with seat, deep soaking tub, great lighting, in floor heat and a lot of storage. To do this, the toilet and shower switched locations, with the vanity and tub remaining in their original spots. Brushed bronze finishes on the plumbing fixtures and shower door, porcelain tile, cherry cabinets, and *Topic Brown* granite tops all make a dramatic change without changing the wall configuration. This bathroom was given an update that fulfilled all the design goals, increased functionality and embodies warmth and subtle elegance.
